From the pastor...

So this month of July is the month when we celebrate Independence Day. The Fourth of July commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence. The original 13 colonies declared themselves a new nation: the United States of America. There will be fireworks and parades and barbecues and picnics and family reunions. Family reunions? Yes! July is also family reunion month. Just thought I would toss in that fun fact.

Jesus has set us free. Paul wrote to the Galatians, "For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery." The Galatians accepted the good news of grace. They were saved by grace. But then they got it into their heads that they had to start adding obedience to their faith in order to be made right with God. Paul told them they had been set free from that burden. They were set free to live in freedom.

I remind us this month that our salvation is a gift. We are saved by grace through faith. This is the gift of God. The thing about a gift is it is a gift. We do not earn a gift. Earning can be a burden. That burden has been lifted. So as we celebrate and observe freedom this month, let's remember that Jesus has set us free...free indeed. A gift is a thing we receive that has been paid for by someone else. Jesus paid for the gift of our freedom from sin and death.

Then Jesus said, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free...So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed." (John 8:31-31, 36)
