From the pastor...

A friend was recently working on a sermon. It was a sermon on the Church. He used Facebook to do a little research. He asked his Facebook friends, "I'd love to hear your answers to this question as I prepare for Sunday's message: what do you like best about the Church?"

As many of you know, I do not often respond to Facebook posts. But I thought about this. I responded. I said what I think I like most about the Church is it is made up of a bunch of very imperfect people, and somehow God uses these imperfect people to accomplish great things." Grace! (There is that clichéd thought: when I find the perfect church, I will join it. Then it won't be perfect any longer. Grace!)

There is one place in Scripture where I think we see Jesus at his most joyful. He sent out seventytwo of his followers. He sent them out in pairs. He sent them to preach the kingdom. He knew he was sending them out "like lambs among wolves". The seventy-two returned with joy. They reported to Jesus, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." Jesus told them the thing that should bring them the most joy was their names being recorded in heaven.

The account then says that Jesus was full of joy through the Holy Spirit. Jesus was full of joy. He prayed, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little Children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure."

Little children. God did not choose the highfalutin people of society. He chose fishermen and tax collectors and hotheads and zealots and other quite imperfect people. With them Jesus started the Church. God used them to do great things. The Church is still here. We, imperfect though we are, are the Church. God still uses us to accomplish wonderful things.

We are blessed to be the Church.

Adult Ministry and Worship-Pastor Dan: Adult Bible Study will end on May 17 and will resume in the Fall. There has been great attendance during the classes. Currently studying the Book of Hebrews. The Book of Hebrews will be finished when classes resume in the Fall. Wednesday night seems to be the best evening for the classes.

<u>Worship Design</u>: Pastor Dan indicated that we would be moving service outside for the July 2nd service. Time will remain at 9:00 am. Also, there will be another service outside scheduled for August.

<u>Club Rock – Youth Ministry</u>: Club Rock is currently ending for this year. Funds raised to send our youth to camp this year reached its goal of 100%. 15 youth will be attending camp this year. Thanks to everyone who donated and made this possible to send our youth to this wonderful camp. Many of the kids going to camp are involved in service projects out of appreciation for all the funds raised to send them to camp.
