### From the pastor...

May is the month we celebrate Pentecost. Pentecost arrives fifty days after Passover. Some fifty days after Jesus rose from the grave, Jews from all over gathered once again in Jerusalem. They were there to celebrate the giving of the law to Moses. On that day God poured out the Holy Spirit. The disciples were empowered to proclaim the good news in the languages of all the people who were gathered there. Jesus told the disciples they would receive power when the Holy Spirit came upon them. They would then be witnesses to the ends of the earth. But they would begin right where they were... in Jerusalem.

"We will proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to a lost and hurting world, beginning in Chisago County." That is the mission statement of First United Methodist Church. People need to hear good news these days. They need to hear the good news. We are the ones to tell them. We begin right where we are. Where we are is always the best place to begin.

For each of us, as followers of Jesus, we also share the good news, and we begin where we are. We share the good news with our family and with our friends. We share the good news where we work. ## HELP Health Equipment Lending Program

Do you or someone you know need temporary medical equipment?

HELP began in 2010 with the idea of three men from the community (two from Trinity Lutheran Church and one from First UMC) who saw the need for health equipment to be available to all who may have need of it.

HELP offers used medical equipment to anyone with a temporary need. The equipment can be "borrowed" for up to six months, but can be extended with a phone call for a maximum borrow time of one year. The equipment is housed at First UMC.

The equipment is donated by individuals and health care providers. It is cleaned and sanitized before being issued for use.
