A Christian non-profit founded in 1987, Feed My Starving Children tackles world hunger by sending volunteer-packed, nutritious meals to 70 countries, where they're used to operate orphanages, schools, clinics and feeding programs to break the cycle of poverty.

Last year, FMSC welcomed nearly 1.1 million volunteers to pack more than 284 million meals to feed more than 779,000 kids daily for a year. The Minnesotabased charity spends more than 90% of total annual donations directly on feeding kids.

From the pastor...

Dear Friends,

Recently, while driving, I saw a billboard advertising a new church. In big bold letters that stretched across the entire billboard it read, "A Great Church for a Fresh Start!"

It is apparent to me that church wants to attract people who have either had negative experiences in their previous churches or who perhaps are unchurched and have never had a church home. Maybe they are trying to reach those who feel as if their church has let them down, or that their church is no longer meeting their needs. They want to send the message that "if you come here you can start fresh", or "this isn't like your old church", or "this church will give you what you're looking for!"

As I began to think more about that motto I realized how misleading it is. Any church that faithfully and truthfully preaches the Gospel of Jesus Christ ought to be a great church for a fresh start. Meeting opened with a prayer from Pastor Dale

Finance: We are currently on track regarding income and expenses. This is good news for this time of year. Year to date all bills have been paid and things are looking good. Our congregation has really stepped up in the midst of our pastoral transition. We are grateful. Funds came in this month for the parking lot project that pays it in full. Thanks to all who contributed to this very worthy cause. This month, funds are coming in well for the Mission of the Cemetery fund.

<u>Adult Ministries:</u> Pastor Dale is planning on resuming the Wednesday evening adult Bible study in September. He plans on using a curriculum entitled, "Daily Discipleship" that is based on the upcoming Sunday preaching text. This topic will be ending in September and replaced with something new. All are encouraged to attend.
