From the pastor...

Rejoice In the Lord Always - Even During Lent!

Lent is my favorite season of the Church year. I like the opportunity it presents each year to focus on the wilderness journey of life that leads to the empty tomb of victory and triumph on Easter. This is an important opportunity for us not only once a year, but daily, as we place our hope and trust in the new life of resurrection.

Typically, Lent has been thought of as a season of self-sacrifice and discipline that sounds, to many Christians, like a list of spiritual chores. Lenten disciplines become the spiritual equivalent of New Year's resolutions to lose weight, be healthier, or practice better money management. These promises are easily made and often quickly broken, leaving us feeling like we do not measure up. This is not an accurate or healthy view of the Lenten season.

But what if we approached Lent differently? What if we approached Lent with a spirit of joy instead of lament or despair?

In his letter to the Philippians, the apostle Paul joyfully turns to spiritual practices that draw him closer to God amid persecution and imprisonment. These practices continually keep Paul connected to a sense of God's power and presence. Joy flows from Paul and becomes a vital part of his relationship with the Philippians.

You're invited to join us this Lenten season on Wednesday nights at 6:00 p.m. in the Church Lounge for a six-week study of this letter of Paul's to the Philippians. The study is based on a book called, Because of This I Rejoice and it explores what Paul teaches about joyfully practicing spiritual disciplines. The goal of this study will be to help us focus less on ourselves and more on God as we learn to engage in the same spiritual practices as a way to grow closer to God and allow joy to flow through our daily lives.


Participants are encouraged to purchase the book on their own. I hope you'll be able to participate. Please invite a friend whom you think might enjoy or benefit from this study.

The first meeting of the *new* Circle was held on February 9, 1981 in the church lounge. No decision was decided from the possible names suggested for the Circle: Hope, Lydia, and Dorcas. The group decided "that we should pray about it and vote on a name at the next meeting." The March minutes states "We decided to call ourselves **Hope Circle.**"

February 20, 2019, 8:00 p.m.

Present: Pastor Dale Stiles, Chair Terry Keesee, Cindy Kopp, Sarah Clark, Don Arnold, Scott Lecy, Lloyd Jones, Juanita Morgan, and visitor Ron Morgan

Committee Reports

Trustees----Lloyd Jones reported that Susan Meinholz is a new member of Trustees. Lloyd also complimented touch-up and painting done by Jeff Meinholz.

Foundation---Donn Arnold reported that the Youth Using Computers system has been approved by the Foundation and is ready to be installed by Greg Oien. Estimated cost is \$418.35.

Missions—The position of Chair. is still not filled. Two people are considering it.

Publicity & Social Media—Erin Thorvaldson reported that she and Pastor Dale are pleased with the success of the Web Site and Facebook.

Lay Leader-No report

Finance---Scott Lecy reported he had just submitted the 2019 Budget today. Total January giving was \$11,500—short of what was hoped for. February is slow for donations. The recent electric bill was \$1600 for the month. The thermostats are turned down to conserve.

SPRC—**Pastor Dale** recapped the meeting of the SPRC with District Superintendent **Susan Nienaber** She provided a helpful review of expectations of SPRC and left hand-outs addressing responsibilities of the members. She also suggested our church repeat the Rules of Christ in-service which was held over eight years ago. Current members are unfamiliar with it. She also encouraged the Committee to invite other community churches to participate. How to address wants and needs of church---Conflict Resolution---would be a component of the 'training' led by lay volunteers.

Pastor Dale---Methodist clergy from the area meet monthly for lunch. They met at Phil's Grill in Center City this month. **Pastor Dale** asked the Council for prayer about upcoming decisions the denomination will have to make regarding same sex marriage, and gender issues. He reviewed Lenten observation dates and plans. Six youth are in Confirmation class. The Wednesday book study "The Life You've Always Wanted" will conclude soon and a new Lenten study on the book of Philippians will begin March 13.

Worship Design Team—Team is still making decisions on the design for Lent & Easter

Children, Youth, & Ministry—Erin said the Children's Sunday, February 3 was a **Super Sunday!** March 17 will be a fundraising Sunday for Youth Camping & Mission Trip this summer.

Women's Bible Study—Cindy Kopp said the Tuesday morning study is finishing its study of Parables. Women are invited to attend Lenten study prior to Easter.

Strategic Pathway Task Force—Greg Oien, who will 'Chair' the group, recapped the first meeting held after church on Feb. 10. Thirteen people were present. It was agreed that the group would meet once a month on the Sunday prior to Church Council. Agenda includes picking four topics to address in small groups.

Hospitality—Juanita shared some thoughts: ushers & greeters to wear nametags Sunday Mornings; desire for more women to participate in Hope Circle; an outing to The Grumpy Minnow in Center City in May; and the importance of Hospitality that leads to Fellowship.
